KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. D. Gilreath,

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. Arthur Tally

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. Arthur Tally and his heirs and assigns:
 All that certain tract of land containing fifty-eight and
 thirty-six one hundredths (58.36) acres, known as a portion of the Gil-
 reath lands, in O'Neal Township, of Greenville County, South Carolina,
 located on the public road leading from Fairview School to Gilreath's
 mill, three miles northwest from Greer, on the waters of Clear Creek,
 and now in the possession of J. A. Tally, bounded on the north by
 lands of J. D. Beacham, on the east by lands of M. M. Bramlett,
 Le Roy Bramlett and Willie Bramlett, on the south by lands of
 Sam Rushton and T. J. Owens, and on the west by lands of J. D.
 Beacham. Said tract of land is particularly described according
 to a plat prepared by W. B. Brockwell, Surveyor, on the 7th day of
 September 1933, as follows, to wit:

Beguning at an iron pin on the road leading from Fairview School to Gilreath Mill, the southeastern corner of said tract, and running thence
 with said road N. 15 degrees E. 511.7 feet to a stone, thence N. 5 degrees E. 712
 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 4 degrees and 30 minutes E. 870 feet to an
 iron pin, thence S. 77 degrees and 25 minutes W. 1731 feet to an ash,
 thence S. 25 degrees and 57 minutes W. 2925 feet to a persimmon,
 thence S. 4 degrees and 25 minutes W. 574 feet to a hickory, thence N.
 89 degrees E. 238 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 30 degrees and 30
 minutes E. 151.3 feet to a poplar, thence S. 58 degrees and 17 minutes
 E. 200 feet to a sweet gum, thence S. 80 degrees and 50 minutes
 E. 458.5 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 8 degrees and 15 minutes
 W. 366.4 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 75 degrees E. 759 feet to
 the beginning corner.
