KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Edward D. Simmons,

in the State aforesaid,

O. St. Alexander.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. Clara M. and O. St. Alexander, their heirs and
assigns:

All of my right, title and interest, the same
being $\frac{85}{100}$ of an undivided one-fourth interest in and to
all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in the City of Greenville, State of South
Carolina, Greenville County, on the west side of North Main
Street, and the south side of West Coffee Street, and on the
East side of Laurens Street, and having the following metes
and bounds, to wit:

Begins at a point on the west side of North Main
Street, which point is approximately 69 feet south of the
southwest intersection of North Main Street and West Coffee
Street, and running thence along the west side of North Main
Street in a northerly direction 69 feet, more or less, to the inter-
section of North Main Street and West Coffee Street, thence
along the south side of West Coffee Street in a southerly
direction 242 feet, more or less, to the southeast intersection
of West Coffee Street and Laurens Street, and running
thence along the East side of Laurens Street in a southerly
direction 70 feet, more or less, to line of property occupied by

above property has been previously conveyed by me to
A. C. Mann, J. L. Oylee, and W. St. Arnold by deed recorded
in Deed Book 175, page 522, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County,
and the interest here conveyed in the above described land
and premises is an undivided seventeen eightieth $\frac{17}{80}$ in
and to the same.

dated the 24th of October 1933, and duly probated and
