(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

C. G. Myche and A. C. Mann an undivided one-fifth interest each in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, S. C., lying on both sides of the road running from Walker's cross roads to Pelham Road near the Western end of said tract, and passing through said farm, which tract contains  $112 \frac{1}{3}$  acres, and is known as Tract no. 2 on a plat of the property of the estate of A. B. Montgomery prepared by Th. J. Piddle, February 21, 1935, and revised by him on March 3, 1935, and according to said plat has the following metes, bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone a short distance south-east of the intersection of the above mentioned roads, corner of Pector property, and running thence with the line of Pector property, N. 70° E. 1525 feet to a stake in road leading to Greenville, thence S. 34° 20' 59" E. 594 feet to a stake, joint corner with Pector property, thence S. 53° 45' E. 824 feet to an iron pin (new corner), thence N. 33° 30' E. 3234 feet to an iron pin on M. G. Greene property line, thence with said line N. 52° 40' 20" E. 520 feet to a stone in branch, thence with said branch, as the line the following courses and distances, to-wit: S. 44° 45' 20" E. 906 feet to a corner thence S. 66° 20' 748 feet to a corner, thence S. 54° 45' 20" E. 370 feet to a corner, thence N. 82° 30' 20" E. 328 feet to a stone, thence N. 78° 15' 20" E. along line of M. G. Greene property, and across the Pelham Road 7507 feet to a stone, thence S. 70° E. across the Pelham Road and across the Greenville Road 1772 feet to a stone, the beginning corner, and being a part of the tract of land formerly owned jointly by A. B. Montgomery and Anvary Vaughn Montgomery.
