

First and in consideration of One hundred dollars, payment of which is hereby acknowledged, we the undersigned, Parkers School District, hereby grant and convey unto the Pastel Telegraphic Cable Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telegraphic and Telephonic, including the necessary poles, wires, cables and fixtures, over and across the land which we own, or in which we have any interest, in the County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, which right of way may be identified as follows:

Bounds known as Parkers High School, adjoining Bramble Street, City View.

The right-of-way is permission to erect one line of poles only, and upon and along the roads, streets or highways in front of the adjoining said land, with the right to permit the attachment of the wires and cables of any other company, and the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires and cables cleared, at least eighteen inches, and to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.
