the receipt whereof is acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mr. Clydes. Potters, all that certain piece of ground situate, lying, and being in Fair Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and having the following bounds: Beginning at a point in the center of Guncombe Road and running to an iron post in edge of said Road (said post being 125 feet to the west of a cast iron monument); thence N. 73.05° & 290.5 feet from starting point to an iron post in center of County road, thence N. 60.85° & 221.7 feet to iron post, thence N. 01.45° & 216 feet to an iron post; thence N. 45.35° & 162 feet, thence N. 66.80° 200 feet to another iron post; thence N. 14.30° & 266 feet to an iron post; thence S. 87.15° W. 277 feet to a black gum tree; thence N. 36.20° W. 147.3 feet; thence S. 34.30° W. 674.4 feet to the center of Guncombe Road; thence S. 64.45° E. 365 feet to the starting point and containing sixteen acres more or less, being bounded on the North by land of topic course on the West by Mr. R.
