Lewis Barber: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina in the First Ward of the City of Greenville having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Briggs Avenue, corner of lot belonging to C. P. Ballenger and running S 57 21/2 W with said Avenue, 50 feet to a stake, corner of Lot belonging to Pinson; thence S 33 E with Pinson's line 180 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence N 57 E with said alley, 50 feet to an iron pin, Ballenger's back corner; thence N 57 21/2 W with Ballenger's line 180 feet to the beginning corner on Briggs Avenue.
