to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. S. Watson,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
J. S. Watson,

"All that tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County
aforesaid, on Waters of Rocky Creek, adjoining lands of Thomas H. Cole, William H.
Austin and others, and containing Sixty-Five (65) acres, more or less, being the land
conveyed to W. N. Green by J. M. Chandler by deed dated December 16, 1875, and recorded
in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book GG, page 726. Less, however,
Fourteen (14) acres, from the above tract of land conveyed by W. N. Green as follows:

(a) By deed of W. N. Green to J. B. Razor dated November 20, 1914, and
recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 26, Page 423, conveying
two acres.

(b) By deed of W. N. Green to G. G. Green dated March 3, 1916, and
recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 44, at page 187, con-
veying twelve acres."

The land herein conveyed is the same land that was devised to us by our
father, the late W. N. Green, by his last will and Testament which is now of record
in the office of Probate Court for Greenville County, S.C. in Apartment 234, File 7.
