Office for said Greenville County, and this deed covers all of the original tract of land conveyed by M. R. Hodges May 20, 1920, recorded in Deed Book 55, Page 344, except 50 acres which Emma Lou Howard conveyed to Jessie Howard, deed being recorded in Deed Book 107, Page 346, and now containing 70.5 acres, more or less.
