on the Buncombe Road and having the following lines, courses and distances:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Buncombe Road, being the intersection of Buncombe Road with the Southern side of the lot conveyed to Lee Woodall, H. B. Allen & Co. to Broome as Trustee of the Union Bleaching Methodist Church, Methodist Episcopal Church South by Union Bleaching & Finishing Co. by deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 25, page 538 and running thence N. 87-40 E. 207.4 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 4-17 E. 210 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 87-40 W. 207.4 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Buncombe Road; thence with Buncombe Road N. 4-17 W. 210 feet to the beginning, containing one acre, more or less. Being the same property conveyed to J. W. Box by Leonard Box as Committee for Lawrence Box, and Lawrence Box by deed dated December 21, 1928 and recorded in R. M. C.
