Zimmerman as Trustee for Sam R. Zimmerman; Jr.,:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, and more particularly described as follows: to-wit:

In the City of Greenville, on the south side of E. Washington Read, fronting on E. Washington Read 50 feet with a depth of 150 feet and being known and designated as lot No. 8 In Block E, of the East Park Addition to City of Greenville, as shown on plat recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in plat book A, page 383, reference being had unto said plat and a more complete description will appear, being the same conveyed to Mary G. Traxler by E. Inman, Master by deed dated May 17, 1927, recorded in book 139, page 30.

Also all those lots known as Lots Nos. 130, 140, 141, 142, 143, and 144 as shown on plat of traxler Park made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, recorded in R. M.
