near Welcome Jason house just off the White Horse and Anderson Roads, containing six acres more or less being all of lot no 16 of the Town property and 56/100 of an acre taken from lot no 15 as shown on plat recorded in plat book #4, page 49, and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe corner of J. M. Fortner, on new cut road, and running thence with Fortner's line N. 52-55 E. 237 feet, thence N. 61-30 E. 534 feet to branch, thence branch the line N. 48-30 W. 120 feet, thence N. 61-20 E. 209 feet, thence N. 62-40 W. 30 feet, thence parallel with line of lot no 16 as shown on said plat S. 61-20 W. 311.5 feet to corner of road; thence with road S. 58-33 E. 410 feet to beginning.
