

## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ella Hampton, all of my interest in  
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

"All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and  
being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just South  
of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being  
known and designated as a part of Lot 4 of Block 10 on  
the plat of the property of Thomas T. Parker, which plat  
is recorded in the office of P. M. C. for Greenville County, in  
Plat Book 6, page 149, and being more particularly described  
as follows: Beginning at a stake on the east side of Valentine  
Street at the common corner of Lots 3 and 4 and running thence N.  
64° 35' E. 157.16' to a stake, thence N. 22-35.31.37 feet to a stake; thence S.  
64° 35' E. 157 feet to a stake on Valentine Street, thence S. 22-18 E. 37 feet  
to the beginning corner; this being the property at 110 Valentine Street,  
the above described land is a part of the property conveyed to  
A. E. Boyd and S. M. Sharpe by Thomas T. Parker and recorded in  
Book 73, page 240, and then conveyed by A. E. Boyd and S. M. Sharpe
