as Trustees for Pendleton Street Baptist Church,in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. K. Jones, G. R. Bushee, and H. J. Southern as Trustees for Pendleton Street Baptist Church, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville, on the east side of Perry Avenue, (sometimes known as White Street), having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning on the east side of said street, corner of Pendleton Street Baptist Church lot, thence in line with the church lot $71\frac{1}{2}$ E. 100 feet to lot of Mrs Cely (Means line) thence with Mrs Cely's line (formerly Main line) 21.21 E. 54 feet to an iron pin; thence $8.71\frac{1}{2}$ N. 100 feet to said Perry Avenue; thence along the East side of Perry Avenue 8217.55 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot described in the deed from Charles M. Jenkins, et al. to the grantor, Mattie E. Jenkins, dated November 17, 1932, and recorded in Deed Book 168, page 100, R. M. C.
