Be it enacted so that all and singular the inhabitants of the State of Mississippi, do witness and declare that they do hereby ordain and establish the same to be the true and only Constitution of the State of Mississippi, and that the same shall be valid and in force from and after the first day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three (1833). And that the Legislature of the said State do make and pass such laws as may be necessary to provide for the execution of the same.
