Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the county and State aforesaid in or near the Town of Greer, and known as lot #6 in block No. 3, of a plat of land recorded in the office of register mesne conveyance in and for the county of Greenville in plat Book "A", and being the same lot of land conveyed me by W. P. Gibson by deed bearing date of Nov. 17, 1934, and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 92 page 591. It is agreed by the parties of this deed that the above described property shall not be leased sold or otherwise let for the use of persons of African descent, and in case any such transfer is made or attempted to be made the property shall revert to Thos. Keating and D. O. Leonard their heirs or assigns.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by W. F. Gibson, on the 17th day of November 1924, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 92, Page 591.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs. Elsie B. Dill, her heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs. Elsie B. Dill, her heirs and assigns, against all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
