near to nestee Mill, containing one fourtenth of an acre, more or less, ad joining lands of E. S. H. Myron, Aaron Walker, J. St. Shores, and others on the Standing Spring Road, and having the following corners and boundaries, to wit: Beginning at a tree on east side road Standing Spring Road and running thence S. 88 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2.47 chains to lawn iron pen; thence N. 20 E. 93 links to over iron pen; thence N. 70 W. 3.16 chains to another pen on south road; thence along said road 1.61 chains to the beginning corner and, being the same lot conveyed to H.
