Slearyin the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Bessie J. Sleary her heirs and assigns forever

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Bennett Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina about three and one-half miles south of the City of Greenville, near Burkard Mill Road, bounded by lands of myself, J. P. James and J. P. Grayson, and having the following outlet and bounds to wit:

Begins at a Post Oak S & E Southeast of the dwelling and running thence N. 47<sup>40</sup> E. 4.40; thence N. 14<sup>55</sup> E. 4.98 to a pine; thence N. 68<sup>55</sup> E. 11.75 to a pine; thence N. 20<sup>50</sup> E. 10.80 to a pine; thence S. 66<sup>40</sup> E. 4.48 to iron post on J. P. James' corner thence S. 20<sup>50</sup> E. 11.60 to iron pine; thence S. 68<sup>55</sup> E. 11.50 to a rock; thence S. 66<sup>40</sup> E. 6.68 to a big white cornel; thence N. 30<sup>50</sup> E. 5.9 to same pine; thence S. 8<sup>40</sup> E. 1.12; thence S. 60<sup>50</sup> E. 3.70; thence N. 47<sup>40</sup> E. 4.40 bounded to the beginning cornel, containing 10 acres more or less.

Sleary shall have, and every other person holds and assigns, myself, my heirs and my executors and administrators whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
