C. office for said County in Plat Book C, page 16, and having according to said plat the following described boundaries; Beginning at the southeast corner of the ten foot alley, corner of Lot No. 14 and running thence with said alley N. 72° 50' 00" E. 41 feet to an iron fence corner of Lot No. 12; thence S. 15° 15' 00" E. 124 feet to an iron gate; thence further eastward direction along a fence 94.5 feet to the iron gate; thence N. 11° 00' 00" E. 119.6 feet to the beginning; being the northern portion of said Lot No. 13.
