Beginning at iron pin in the center of Augusta Road, 20 rods N. of quadrant, L. C. Jenkins and J. H. Martin estate, and running thence with Augusta Road West 4.59 chains to iron pin in center of road; thence with Martin line S. 80.50 E. 3.41 to iron pin; thence still with Martin line N. 0.15 S. 3.17 to iron pin, corner of G.
