Conveyances office for Greenville County in Vol. C, page 108, which plat is a
revision of Lots Nos. 20, 21, and 22, Section "C", Stone Land Company, and being
more particularly described as follows:Beginning at an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 of said
property, and thence S. 71-30 West along Earle Street 60 feet to an iron pin; thence
S. 17-41 W. 146.3 feet to an iron pin at the Chick Springs Road; thence along Chick
Springs Road S. 60-51 W. 5.1 feet; thence N. 71-30 W. 58.5' to an iron pin; thence
