Bright, a right of way for ingress and egress to and from all that place, part or lot of land in Sarana Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 415 acres more or less, owned by J. D. Bright, over that tract of land in the Township, county and state aforesaid, containing 86 acres more or less, owned by me, said right of way to enter the 86 acre tract at line of D. W. Patterson and run to Perry Creek Holiness Baptist Church, following the Pine Ridge Road by the Church, on through the line of Mary Nielson and N. K. Nielson, said right of way having been heretofore reserved by me in the deed which I made the Nielsons.

Said 86 acre tract is the balance of the tract conveyed to F. C. Bright by J. D. Bright, by deed dated April 14, 1924, recorded in Book 7B, page 569.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by the above named person on the day of January 16th, 1924, by Deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyances for Greenville County, in book 7B, page 569.
