in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said M. W. Bright,

all that gives, giveth or hath of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Pelham Road and being known and designated as Tract No. 5 of the V. Perry Hudson land as shown on plat made by Dalton & Nevers November, 1928, and having the following lines and bounds according to said plat, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Pelham Road corner of lands of T. B. Jones and running thence with his line and the line of E. P. Hudson, N. 6-00 W. 2108 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 88-52 E. 553 feet to a stone; thence S. 75-30 E. 839 feet to an iron pipe corner of Tracts Nos. 3, 4, 5 and 6; thence with the joint line of Tracts 3 and 5, S. 1-30 W. 1000' 6 feet to pipe on the Pelham Road; thence with said road as the line S. 87-58 W. 1000 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 57.75 acres, more or less, and being one of the Tracts of land conveyed to me by J.
