## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT Mary J. Bates,In the State aforesaid County of Greenvillein consideration of the sum of One -- \$31.00

Dollars,

and love and affection for my daughter Louie Batesand me paid by Louie Bates

In the same aforesaid, the premises whereof by buying aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Louie Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

all the given, granted or be all land in Greenville, near the city limits of the city of Greenville, known as lot No. 3 on plat of property of Mary J. Bates made by J. J. Riddle, July 27th, 1934, and having the following notes and bounds, according to said plat;

beginning at an iron pin on east side of Austin Street, center of ten foot alley, corner of lot of James C. Bates, and running thence with center of said alley N. 84-30 E. 89 feet to iron pin, corner lot No. 2 on said plat, thence with line of said lot No. 2, S. 23 E. 68.5 feet to iron pin; thence S. 55-30 W. 26 feet to iron pin; thence S. 72 W. 84.5 feet to iron pin on Austin Street; thence with Austin Street N. 0 W. 53.5 feet to beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to the right of James U. Bates to use said 16-foot alley for the purpose of ingress and egress to and from his lot lying on the north side of the lot hereinabove conveyed, said alley extending from Austin Street a distance of 180 feet along the north side of the lot conveyed to Mary J. Bates by James C. Bates by his deed dated Nov. 7, 1921, recorded in R. R. U. O. for said County in Deed book 75, page 45; and also to the right of Mary J. Bates, her heirs and assigns, to use said alley for the benefit of lots Nos. 1 and 2 on said plat.

The above described land is a portion of the same conveyed to the by James U. Bates, on the 7th day of November 1921, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 75, Page 45.
