In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **Theresa Barnes**, all of the grantor's right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-fourth interest in and to **Greenville**,

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

and being known and designated as lot No. 7, Block No. 1, according to page 74 of the Greenville, S. C. City Plat Book, and being situate on the North side of Markley Street in the City of Greenville, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Markley Street, corner of lot now or formerly owned by the Misses Cora and Anne E. Parker, and running thence with Markley Street in a Northwesterly direction 301 feet more or less to a point on a 16 foot alley; thence in a Northeasterly direction 123 feet more or less to a point; thence in a Southeasterly direction 301.5 feet more or less to point; thence in a Southwesterly direction 125 feet more or less to the beginning corner.
