

## LEASE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

We, W. E. Bush and C. A. Turner, lessor,  
in consideration of the rental hereinabove mentioned, have granted, bargained and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, and lease unto  
H. H. Allen, Distributor, lessee,  
for the following use, viz: dwelling is to be used as a residence; filling station  
to be used as a service station, the  
for the term of One (1) year.

in consideration of the use of and premium for the said term, premium to pay the said lessor the sum of One Thousand Twenty  
and no/00 Dollars.

The lessor agrees to take the building just as it stands when delivered from the builder, and the lessee only required of the lessor the use of the  
premises for the business mentioned but no other. The lessor to repair the said rental if lessor, it is also fully agreed that the roof is considered sound and the  
lessor not to pay any damages from rent should any occur. Use of the premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the  
lessee so desires and give notice of same in writing.

If the lessor is discontinued in the premises owned before the expiration of the term then the whole of the unpaid time between himself and the

Outside signs to be erected that may conflict with the property or any other outside part of the building must be removed to by the lessor before he  
is entitled to additional year or rate of \$100.00 per month, commencing April 1,  
1941 and continuing every April 1, 1942.

Lessee is to have the right to sub-rent the above mentioned  
house and studio separately if so desired.

To have and to hold the said premises unto the said lessor, his executors and administrators for the said term. It is agreed by the parties hereto that this lease shall continue from year to year on the same terms, unless the  
party desiring to terminate it after the expiration of the term above mentioned give to the other party, one month written notice previous  
to the time of the desired termination, but the destruction of the premises by fire or pulling it down for occupancy or other cause, or
