(the equipment herein is hereby acknowledged, have Contracted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*J. P. Stanley has these and assigns forever,*  
All that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land, lying  
situate and being in Garrett Township, Greenville County,  
South Carolina, on the Augusta Road, and having the follow-  
ing metes and bounds to wit:  
*Beginning at a rock on the north east side of Augusta*  
*Road, and running thence with Augusta Road N. 45.45 E.*  
*15.66 to an iron post corner of a ten acre tract conveyed*  
*by J. A. Brockman to F. G. Gillaspie June 21st, 1928, and run-*  
*ning thence with line of said ten acre tract S. 19.25 E. 19.30;*  
*the line S. 47.10 E. 1.16 to a rock, thence S. 50.36 E. to an iron pi-*  
*le corner S. 54.10 E. 7.05 to an iron post, thence N. 53.10 E. 7.94 to*  
*a rock thence N. 40.27 E. 16.11 to a rock on Augusta Road,*  
*the point of beginning, and containing 28.86 acres, more or*  
*less, and being a portion of tract conveyed to J. A. Brockman*  
*by A. Fuller, deed dated Nov. 19, 1918, and recorded in the office*  
*of the Register of Deeds conveyances in and for Greenville*  
*County, South Carolina, in Vol 34 at page 52, and the same*  
*property conveyed to me by J. A. Brockman Nov. 8, 1928, deed*  
*recorded in Vol 133, at page 34, said Register's Office.*

As a part consideration for this conveyance the grantee  
herein assumes and agrees to pay according to the terms  
thereof a certain note given by J. A. Brockman to Charles  
McAllister under date of June 21st, 1928, and secured by  
mortgage over the within premises, recorded in Vol 200  
at page 212, aforesaid Register's Office, balance due on  
said mortgage being the sum of two thousand dollars.
