A. H. Hood, his heirs and assigns forever: All my right  
title and one half interest in and to all that certain piece  
parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Butler  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on  
both sides of Rocky Creek and on the south side of the  
road leading from Greenville City to Batesville and having  
the following of metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake 34 m. N. 34° 0' W. 340 gone, on said creek  
and running thence N. 48° 11' 12.30 to a pine 340 m. dead, thence  
N. 33° 11' 17.50 to a stone 340 m. thence N. 21° 42' 10.44 to a stone  
340 m. in Hickory stump 340; thence S. 54° 2' W. along south  
side of Batesville Road 5.36 to a stone 340 m. thence S. 7° E. 5540  
to stone 340 m.; thence S. 35° 2' W. 5.30 to sweet gum 340 m., bank  
of rocky creek above ford; thence S. 8° 4' W. 13.50 to a stone  
340 m.; thence S. 34° E. 15.00 to a stone 340 m. P. O. gone; thence  
N. 73° 12' E. 2.86 to a P. O. 340 m. thence S. 11° 2' E. 19.60 to a stone  
340 m.; thence S. 8° E. 12.75 to a stone 340 m. at the end of hedge  
row; thence S. 64° 2' E. 15.55 to a stone 340 m.; thence N. 29° 18'  
21.75 to a stone 340 m.; thence N. 65° 34' E. 20.00 to a stone 340 m.  
thence N. 13° 12' E. 12.32 to a stone 340 m. on side of road; thence  
along said road as a line 8.20 to a stone 340 m. across  
said creek at ford; thence up the creek with its various  
meanderings to the beginning of adjoining lands formerly  
belonging to W. A. Hudson, John Hudson, George Kralielett,  
William Green, and tract No. 1 and No. 3, the same being  
tract No. 5 of the division of land belonging to Henry T.  
Strand and representing more particularly by plan  
thereof made by J. H. Southern, U. S. on the 1st day of
