(the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

I, Ernest Battelle, John Moore, Samuel Stalling, Trustees  
do above release and convey  
all that lot, tract or parcel of land, situated  
on east side of the Old Rutherford Road, near waters  
of Eno River, in Creek Spring Township, County of  
Greenville, state aforesaid, adjoining lands of Samuel  
Stalling, John Battelle, and other lands of myself,  
and having the following metes and bounds:

Begun being at a stone 380 m. on Sam Stalling  
line, thence S. 15 1/2 W. 4.30 to corner of Old Spartanburg  
Road and on Sam Stalling line, thence with corner of Old  
Rutherford Road N. 19 3/4 W. 4.43 chains to point in center  
of Old Rutherford Road, thence S. 87 3/4 E. 2.49 chains to the  
beginning corner, and containing 53 acres more  
or less, according to survey made by J. E. Freeman, March  
9, 1833.

Further it is the intent of the assignor, J. D. Steadman  
that the above described lands shall be held by the  
above named trustees and their successors, in office  
for religious purposes, and should it ever cease its  
use for religious purposes of the nature heretofore  
explained, said lands shall revert back to the assignor,  
J. D. Steadman, or to his estate.

It is also the will of the assignor, J. D. Steadman, that  
the trustee shall be of the faith held by the Baptist State  
Convention of South Carolina which is the prevailing faith  
of the Prayer meeting group electing the above named trustees,  
and that their successors in office shall be of said  
Baptist faith, and elected by a continuation of the present  
Prayer Meeting group whether it continues in its present  
form, or develops into a Baptist Sunday School and Prayer  
Meeting or into a Baptist Church, and should it develop  
into a Baptist Church such church shall elect trustees  
and shall have power to remove from office any  
who chance to become objectionable and elect others to  
their places.
