Received of the State of South Carolina through the South Carolina State Property Enclosure One and No 10 (\$1.00) To start and
Conveyation of Vehicle & Heavy and into said Commission; its
successor and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct,
operate and maintain the line of telephone, including the necessary
poles, trees, and fixtures, upon, over and across the property which
it takes or in respect of which I take an interest, in the County of Greenville
and State of South Carolina, and upon and along the roads or
highways adjoining said property, and sum to receive in full, pay
that fee each year, and also for the right to permit the establishment
of the wire of any other company, to run to said poles and fix-
tures, and the right to have and to tree along said lines, so far as
these and trees may be cleared at least 10 feet, and the right to cut all
dead or dying trees that are falling would reach the wire, and the
Further right to erect and to the necessary guy and brace poles and
anchors, and to attack them and to bear the necessary guy wires,
and supporting cables in full pay and thereon. Said right of way
is described as follows:

Begins on the East corner of the State Street Creek property
line of J. H. Cleveland and W. C. Hayes and runs through roads in rear of
these houses, thence across road and run thru. A field to road
fronting property line between J. H. Cleveland and J. H. Converse a dis-
tance of approximately one half mile.
