 Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws
 of the State of Delaware, Grantor, for and in Consideration of
 the sum of two hundred twenty four dollars (\$224.00) to it
 paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has bargained, sold,
 and released, and by these Presents does hereby Grant,
 Bargain, Sell and Release, unto C. C. Robinson, of Greenville County,
 State of South Carolina, Grantee, All of its right, title and in-
 terest in and to the timber and trees on that certain parcel
 or plot of ground, situate, lying and being within the bound-
 aries of that certain tract of land commonly known as the
 "Robinson Tract" located on the waters of South Saluda River,
 in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
 said plot of ground being more particularly described
 as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Geer Highway, corner of Lot No. 4
 and running thence with line of lot No. 4, N. 35° 21' 10" 90 feet
 to a stone; thence N. 29. 50 E. 627 feet to a stone; thence S. 35 E. 1986
 feet to a point on Geer Highway corner of Lot No. 6; thence with
 the Geer Highway 600 feet to the beginning corner, contain-
 ing 22.4 acres, more or less, and designated as lot No. 5 on a
 plat thereof made by W. M. Post, February, 1929.

This being a portion of the tract of land over and in
 which the herein Grantor was conveyed certain interests
 and rights under the terms of a deed by J. Woodward and R.
 Mays, Cleveland, et al., to it dated March 17, 1921, and record-
 ed in the office of the Registrar of Meuse Conveyances for

 tor, its Successors and assigns, all the rights of ingress and
 egress over, upon and across the herein described plot of ground,
 together with all the other rights useful, convenient, or neces-
 sary for the cutting, removal, transporting and manufac-
 turing of the timber and trees located in this vicinity,
 as conveyed by J. Woodward Cleveland and R. Mays Cleveland
 to Saluda Laid and Lumber Company in that certain deed
 of record dated March 17, 1921, recorded in the office of
 the Registrar of Meuse Conveyances for Greenville County,
 State of South Carolina, in Volume 61 of Deeds, at Page 145, reference
 to which deed is hereby made for a more complete and
 accurate description of all rights reserved hereunder.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, here-
 ditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong-
 ing or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and To Hold all and singular the Premises before
 mentioned, subject only to the reservations as hereinbefore
 set forth, unto the said C. C. Robinson, his Heirs and assigns.
