in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
 release unto the said J. L. Armstrong

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
 Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known
 and designated as Lot no 12 of the property of the Compton Realty
 Company according to plat of a survey of said property
 made by H. G. Dalton C.E., and recorded in the R. M. C. Office
 for Greenville County, in Plat Book E, page 137, said lot being
 within the City of Greenville and being more particularly
 described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the south side of Tindal Avenue
 66.5 feet from the southeast intersection of Tindal Avenue
 and Jones Avenue and running thence with the south
 side of Tindal Avenue S. 89-07 E. 167 feet to a stake, thence
 S. 0-53 E. 300 feet to a stake on the rear line of Lot no 15;
 thence N. 89-07 E. 651 feet to a stake, joint corner of Lots 12 and
 13; thence N. 0-18 E. 200 feet to a Stake on Tindal Avenue,
 to the point of beginning.

Being the same lot of land conveyed to the
 grantor herein by Louis Sherfesee by deed dated February
 1, 1924 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
 County in Deeds Volume 92, page 349.

As a part of the consideration for this deed the
 grantee acquires and agrees to pay the mortgage executed
 by L. M. Clayton to Maye H. Webb, dated July 30, 1924, in the
 sum of Five Thousand \$5,000.00 Dollars, which mortgage
