Lawis, this day, June 3rd, 1933, for two hundred and sixteen acres (216) of land, more or less, in said County and State, were fully described in said deed, which is here incorporated by reference, and for other considerations, do hereby accept the Trust there in set forth for the uses and purposes therein set forth, and do hereby declare that I hold the legal title thereto, solely as Trustee for said uses and purposes, and upon said torms and with the powers only that are therein set out, the net proceeds from the use and rentals thereof to be applied in the following order,—

Rirst, to the payment of taxes, repairs, cost of upketp and the payment as they nature of instalments of debt secured by mortgage against raid land to Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank, or to any other mortgages making a loan for the satisfaction of said mortgage debt, with interest and attorney's fees in accordance with the terms of said mortgage and and such subsequent mortgage:

Second, to the payment of the costs of any improvements that the Trustee may make upon said land;

Third, to the support and upknep of B. F. Martin and Mrs. C. K. Martin, and the survivor of them, and of any of their descendants living in the family with them, or either of them, any balance from such use and rentals, after the death of the said two persons, to be disposed of in like shares and manner as the proceeds of the said of said real estate by the successor Trustee, after the death of said survivor;

Fourth: in the event of any sale before my death, the proceeds of any sale to be re-invested by we in other property, to be held by me in trust for like uses and purposes as those provided for, with reference to said land;

Fifth, after my death and the death of Mrs. C. K.
