The amount of money said (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) is Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, and the conditions referred to are that the Union Bleachory shall have the right to maintain the frame of the dam as it now is, and should it deem it necessary in the conduct of its business it may insert the gates therein, provided, however, such gates shall hot exceed tourty (30) inches in height above the base, which base shall not be above the normal had of the atream, and such gates shall be raised and kept raised, once each weak for a period of not less than twenty-four (24) hours, provided they shall not remain continuously closed for more than one seek at a time.
