Whereas the last Will and Testament of George Adams, Deceased, State of Drawood, being King County, State of Minnesota, was duly admitted to probate in the office of the Probate Judge for said County and State on the 2d day of January, 1933, whereat the surviving children of said Will, and Aland H. Johnston, were granted letters testamentary and are now acting executors of said Will; and Whereas under Paragraph XXV of said Will, disposing of the remainder estate, and certain Codicils to the said Will duly admitted to probate therewith, the real estate hereinafter described was devised one-half to the said Robert M. Adams (and others) in certain events which have not transpired to benefit the Adams as trustee) and the remaining one-half to George Luther Adams, Jr., co-trustee and in the event at the date of testator's death, said George Luther Adams, Jr., to be less than twenty-five years of age, then to Aland H. Johnston as trustee in his stead, and the said beneficiaries, not having attained the age of twenty-five years, the said Aland H. Johnston is now acting as trustee hereunder and, Whereas, by paragraph XI of said Will, the testator provided as follows: "My trustee under this Will shall have full power and authority to sell, convey, mortgag, exchange, or otherwise deal with any and all real and personal property constituting trust assets — and to execute and deliver on such trustee such deeds — as may be reasonably required in the execution of any of the powers hereby granted"; and

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Robert M. Adams in his own right, and Robert M. Adams and Aland H. Johnston, as Executrixes under the last Will and Testament of George Adams, Deceased, acting jointly, and Aland H. Johnston as trustee under the said last Will and Testament of the said George Adams, Deceased, by virtue of the power and authority aforesaid and

in the presence of the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, make and convey Charles J. Lynch, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain

lot, piece or parcel of land more fully described as follows:

Lot 6, in Section one, map of the property of Carolina Mountains, Inc., known as "Blue Ridge Forest," prepared by E. S. Drayton Engineer, April 1926, not yet recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Conveyances of Greenville County, South Carolina, but a correct copy of which is hereto attached and made a part thereof.

Beginning at an iron pin on the southerly edge of Piedmont Drive, said Drive being forty (40.0) feet wide, and the Northwesterly corner of Lot No 5, Section E, thence with the Easterly edge of Lot 5, Section E, south three degrees two minutes East, Two Hundred (200.0) feet to an iron pin, the Southwesterly corner of Lot No 5, Section E, thence in an Easterly direction, North eighty six degrees fifty eight minutes East, one Hundred (100.0) feet to an iron pin, the Northwest corner of Lot No 7, Section E, thence with the Westerly edge of Lot No 7, Section E, North three degrees two minutes West Two Hundred (200.0) feet to an iron pin at the southerly edge of Piedmont Drive and the Northwesterly corner of Lot No 7, Section E, thence in a westerly direction, with the southerly edge of said Piedmont Drive, North eighty six degrees and fifty eight minutes West one hundred (100.0) feet to an iron pin at the beginning.
