Leavelle to James A. Hoyt by deed dated April 11, 1898 and recorded in the office of the C. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 111, at page 173, and being one of the four tracts conveyed to John St. White by Debed to Hoyt and others by deed dated December 30, 1908 and recorded in the office of the C. M. C., for Greenville County in Book 906 at page 288.
