to be paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Farris Company, Incorporated, its successors and assigns;

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of the Laurens Road, being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the Laurens Road and running thence N. 30° 0' E. 250.44 feet to an iron pin in the center of tract of lot 21.15 Railroad; thence with said railroad N. 49° 10' W. 307 feet to iron pin; thence N. 56° 56' W. 115.6 feet to iron pin; thence N. 56° 56' W. 234.2 feet to iron pin; thence N. 58° 47' W. 231 feet to iron pin; thence N. 58° 47' W. 176.5 feet to iron pin; thence N. 58° 47' W. 176.6 feet to iron pin; thence N. 62° 36' W. 309 feet to iron pin; thence N. 69° 55' W. 135 feet to iron pin; thence S. 46° 30' W. 2037 feet to iron pin; thence S. 68° 45' E. 778 feet to iron pin; thence S. 44° 40' W. 646 feet to iron pin on Laurens Road; thence with said Laurens Road 644 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner; and containing 81.27 acres, more or less; said being part of the tract of land conveyed to J. And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and its successors, heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
