KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

Marenus, Inc.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina,
Greenville, having its principal place of business at

 the sum of Fifteen Thousand DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto L. T. Batson,

All that certain tract of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, wherein is situate the buildings known as Varday Mills, and having the following lines, courses and distances to wit:

Beginning at red Spanish oak stump, corner of property of Furman University and Varday Cotton Mills 34; thence S. 29° 50' E. 146.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 52° 50' E. 120 feet to a stake (ourwood, gone); thence N. 64° 10' E. to a point in center of Reedy River; thence with the meanderings (middle) of Reedy River, in a northerly direction, to a point on the East bank of Reedy River, S.P., corner of Campendown Mills property and Varday Mills property; thence N. 35° 24' 209 feet to a stake, angle in Reedy River; thence N. 15° 3'-15" W. 276 feet to a stake, angle in river; thence N. 18° 45' W. 1361 feet to a stake, angle in river; thence N. 33° 34' 31" feet to a stake, angle in river, near end of dam; thence N. 51° 0' 17" feet to a large boulder 34; thence N. 39° 20' 24" 130 feet to large boulder in ledge of Reedy River; thence S. 31° 30' W. 436 feet across Reedy River, to S.P. 34 in road to Furman University; thence with line of Furman University property S. 44° 0' E. 119.2 feet to the beginning 34, according to survey of W.D. Neves, October 1919.

Being the same land conveyed to the grantor herein named, by the Ninth Bank and Trust Company of Philadelphia, Savers and Excepting, However, by at portion of land situate on the East side of Reedy River and fronting 234 feet on Cleveland Street, said last referred to deed being dated June 24, 1933, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 132 page 190.

Also all right, title, and interest in and to any easement rights, privileges, and/or rights-of-way which the grantor may in any way have by reason of the ownership of said land, including all such rights as were conveyed by L. M. McBee et al, as executors and trustees in liquidation of Varday Mills by quit-claim deed dated March 5, 1931, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 101, page 544, reference to which is here made. This conveyance is made subject to any easements or rights-of-way over the property, including that of the Greater Greenville Sewer District.
