Beginsing at an iron stake 100 feet from the
Southwest corner of Haveland Avenue (formerly Smith
Street), and Hillside Avenue, running along said lines
of Avenue 96.6 feet more or less, to an iron stake (in a
Southern direction); thence in a Western direction 126.4
feet more or less, to an iron stake, thence in a Northern
direction 75.9 feet, more or less to an iron stake, thence in
an Eastern direction 123.3 feet more or less, to the beginning
corner. The above described property known as lots nos.
21 and 22, and shown on plat of Hillside Terrace made
by P. C. Dalton, July, 1933, and recorded September 13, 1933
