Boundary Agreement. Whereas, by deed dated August 18, 1911, recorded August 18, 1911, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "16" at Page 209, Piedmont Realty Company County of Greenville. conveyed to A. C. Taylor Lots #31, #32, #33, #34, and #35 as shown on a plat of the property of Piedmont Realty Company known as "Oakwood", recorded in Plat Book "A" at Whereas, the said A. C. Taylor subsequently rearranged Lots #33, #34 and #36 ao page 434; and as to front 61-2/3rds. feet each on Cox Street, with a depth of 183 feet each in lines parallel to Goldsmith Street; and Whereas, in conveying the said three lots, the said A. C. Taylor correctly describad them in the particular description by metes and bounds fronting 62 feet, more or less on Cox Street, with a depth of 183 feet in lines parallel with Woldsmith Street, but erroneously referred to the said lots as Lots #33, #34 and #35, respectively, of said plat of Oakwood, recorded in Plat Book "A" at Page 424; and Whereas, the undersigned, D. E. Dill, R. E. James and A. B. Groce, are now the owners of the said three lots, Now, there ofre, in order to definitely establish the segarate boundaries of each of the three lots, it is mutually understood and agreed as follows: That A. B. Groce, his heirs and assigns, owns the lot described as follows: "Beginning at the northeast corner of Cox and Goldsmith Streets, and running thence with Goldsmith Street, N. 48-30 E. 183 feet to a 14 foot alley; thence with the western side of said alley, N. 41-30 W. 61-2/3rds, feet to corner of the lot of R. S. James (hereinafter described); thence with the line of said lot, S. 48-30 W. 183 feet to Cox Street; thence with the eastern side of Cox Street, S. 41-30 E. 61-2/3rds. feet to the beginning corner. That R. R. James, his heirs and assigns, owns the lot described as follows: "Beginning at a point on the east side of Cox Street, corner of the lot of A. B. Groce (hereinabove described), 61-2/3rds. feet northwest from Goldsmith Street, and running thence with the line of said Groce lot, N. 48-30 E. 183 feet to a 14 foot alley; thence with the west side of said alley, N. 41-30 W. 61-2/3rds. feet to corner of D. E.
