

## Deed of a Child

State of South Carolina  
County of Greenville

Know All Men By These Presents, That I, Louise Melton, a resident of the State and County aforesaid, in consideration of the love and affection which I have for my four months old son Reginald La Monte Melton, and the confidence which I have in the integrity of A. B. Beeco and Ruth Beeco and in further consideration of their promise to maintain, educate and support my said infant son in the same manner as they would care for their lawful child, do hereby grant to the said A. B. Beeco and Ruth Beeco all right, title and interest which I have or may hereafter have in said minor child and do give to them said minor child to be their own until the said child arrives at the age of twenty-one years.

I do hereby represent that I have been lawfully married and that said child is the child of my lawful husband, who is now dead.

The acceptance of said child by the grantees herein is full evidence of the fact that they have accepted said child under the terms of this deed and that they obligate themselves to support, maintain, educate and care for said child in all respects as though it were born to them in lawful wedlock.

To have, and to hold, said child unto the said A. B. Beeco and Ruth Beeco, their heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby warrant and defend the title to said child unto the said A. B. Beeco and Ruth Beeco, their heirs and assigns against myself and against every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim any interest as parent, custodian or otherwise.

This conveyance is fully understood by me and is made under the provisions of Section 8633 of the Code of Laws for South Carolina for 1932.
