Know All Men by these presents that I John Harbin of Greenville Dist. & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred & fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Andrew Harbin of said State and Dist. Have bargained, granted, sold & released and do by these presents grant, sell & release unto the said Andrew Harbin a parcel of Land containing Sixty-five &  $\frac{1}{2}$  Acres situate in Greenville Dist. & State aforesaid on the south side of Little rocky Creek & one of its branches.

Beginning on a sweet gum on south bank of the Creek & runs with John Sheppard line S 11  $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 38.25 Chains to a P.O. 3X3X N. 58 E. 18 Stake (Deed torn. Not legible. part of description omitted here) E. 19 to stake, S. 86 W. 13 to stake at branch out, N 21 W. 10.50 to white oak 3 X num, thence N. 35 W. 11 Chaines to Stake at the Creek, thence up the meanders of the Creek to the beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold the above premises unto the said Andrew Harbin his heirs & assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Execs. & Adms. to warrant and forever defend the above premises unto the said Andrew Harbin his Heirs & Assigns against myself my Heirs, Execs. & Adms. and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
