(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Federal Subsistence Homesteads Corporation:

All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Brushy Creek Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 22 acres, more or less, and having, according to a plat conceived from surveys of it A. Addison made in 1968, J. E. Freeman in 1936, and Jack Allison in 1934, in following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to w<sup>e</sup>:

Beginsing at a iron pin in the center of the road leading from Brushy Creek Church to Taylors, S.C., and running thence N. 169 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 27.39 chs to a stone; thence N. 25 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. 10.80 chs to an iron pin; thence N. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.30 chs to an iron pin; thence S. 70 E. 6.00 chs; thence S. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2.60 chs to a R. O.; thence S. 39 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 1.50 chs, to a stake; thence S. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 5.00 chs, to a maple; hence S. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 3.90 chs to a stake; thence S. 30 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.20 chs to a stake in old run of Cane Creek; thence with old run of Cane Creek and in a southerly direction 23.8 chs to the points where said old run empties into the present Cane Creek; said points being the joint corner of land of L. A. Jones; thence with the meanders of said Creek, N. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 2.89 feet to a point in said Creek; thence continuing with said Creek N. 49 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 82.5 feet to a point in said Creek; thence still with said Creek N. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 111.1 feet to a point; thence still with said Creek S. 86 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 149.7 feet to a point; thence continuing with said Creek, S. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 171.5 feet; thence still with said Creek S. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 15.1 feet to a point where said Creek intersects the road from Brushy Creek Church to Taylors; thence with the center line of said road N. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.22 chs; thence still with the center of said road N. 73 E. 3.06 chs; thence still with the center of said road, N. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 7.44 chs to a point in center of said road; thence still with center of said road, N. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 0.96 chs to a point in center of said road; thence still with center of said road N. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 6.65 chs to the point of beginning.
