Frances Endel

"All that lot of land lying, situate and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, more fully described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of E. Augusta Drive at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 54 and 55; thence with joint line of said lots S. 21-35 W. 164 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 53; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 53 and 55 N. 71-35 W. 80 feet to an iron pin joint corner of Lots Nos. 53, 55, 58 and 59; thence with joint line of Lots Nos. 58, 55 and 55 N. 21-35 E. 234.7 feet to an iron pin on the South side of said Augusta Drive; thence with the South side of said Drive on a curved line approximately S. 28-40 E. 103.7 feet to beginning, being Lot No. 55, as shown on Plat Book F, Page 23.
