all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, in the North side of Elbaugh Avenue; and being known as part of lot No. 124 as shown in a Plat of East Park made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book A, page 383 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:


