The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and I have given and retained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. R. Hale, Trustee, for Annie R. Hale

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Butler Township, about three and one half miles East of Greenville Court House, and on the South side of the old Greenville-Spartanburg Road, and being a part of two parcels or tracts of land conveyed to me as follows: one tract of thirty two and three tenths (32.3) acres conveyed to me by deed from W. R. Hale Feb. 28th, 1920 and recorded in the P. L. C. for Greenville County in deed book 55 at page 284; and one parcel conveyed to me by deed from J. J. McSwain November 4th, 1920 for twenty seven one-hundredths of an acre and recorded in the R. L. C. office for Greenville County in deed book 71 at page 244, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning on a Red Oak stump on the North East corner of the tract and on the North side of the above named road and runs thence S. 20-15 E. 1395 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74-30 E. 1139 feet to an iron pin on the original line of the tract conveyed to me by W. R. Hale, thence a new line N. 2-05 E. 662-8 feet to an iron pin in the old Greenville-Spartanburg Road; thence with the said road N. 88-15 E. 215.4 feet to a bend; thence continuing with the road N. 79-00 E. 519 feet to an angle in said road; thence N. 76-15 E. 831 feet to the beginning corner, containing Twenty nine and three tenths (29.3) acres more or less; according to plat prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, Oct. 1918, and amended Feb. 3rd, 1934.

The above described land is bounded on the North by the road leading to the old Greenville-Spartanburg Road, on the South by the same, on the East by the same, and on the West by the same, and contains 32.3 acres, more or less, as per survey made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, Oct. 1918, and amended Feb. 3rd, 1934, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds for Spartanburg County, in Book B, page 19.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appurtenant, unto the said W. R. Hale, Trustee for Annie R. Hale, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I, M. E. Brockman, do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W. R. Hale, Trustee for Annie R. Hale, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person whatsoever I may lawfully claim, and to bear the same for any part thereof.
