MITNESSETH

That the Party herein of the First Part does, in consideration of the receipt now here acknowledged of the sum of Three thousand five hundred and no /100 Dollars (\$3,500.00) cash in hand paid and delivered to it by the Party herein of the Second Part, hereby Grant, Bargain, sell alien and convey unto the said Party of the Second Part, his heirs and assigns the following property, to-wit:

All that certain lot or tract or parcel of land lyingand being situated in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, together with gin house, seed house, and any and all other buildings and improvements thereon, also situate, lying and being in Butler Township, State of South Carolina, known as the Verdin Gin Tract, adjoining lands of Estate of G. S. Hamby and others; Beginning at an iron pin on the Pelham Road, and running thence N. 14 E. 7.50 to an iron pin, thence S. 49^{-3}_{-4} E. 4.63 to an iron pin in said road; thence with said road in a southwesterly direction 6.80 to beginning; containing 1.39 acres, more or less.

Also, all gin machinery, power equipment, together with shaft, shafting, belting pulleys, and gin machinery and equipment of any nature whatsoever now situated on the real estate above described belonging to the -arty of the First Part without warranty or representation concerning quality, quantity, or present state of repair.
