That the said party of the first part, in consideration of Ten Dollars and other good and valuable considerations, to her in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has bargained and sold and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:
