All those two certain pieces, lots or parcels of land situate lying and being
in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on Nichols Street, and have the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Lot No. 12; Beginning at a stake on North side of Nichols Street corner of
lot formerly owned by H. J. Haynesworth, thence with Nichols street S. 78 E. 50 feet to a
stake corner of lot No. 13; thence N. 12 E. 100 feet to a stake; thence N. 78 W. 50 feet
to lot of H. J. Haynesworth; thence S. 12 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner. Being
known as lot No. 12 of the Cox property. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Cynthia
