the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. W. Coleman, his heirs and his assigns forever,
all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing twenty
three and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) acres, more or less, lying and being
in Bates Township in the County and State aforesaid on Branch
waters of Beaverdam Creek of Saluda River, being that same
tract of land conveyed to me by H. Y. Bateson by his Deed bearing
date of June 3d, 1899, recorded in P. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Vol. 777 at Page 590. Having the following metes and
