

3. A 2-inch cast iron pipe at the point where Harris Street intersects Bradley Street, Doncaster.
4. A 6-inch cast iron pipe at the point where the Spring Springs Road intersects Bradley and Church Streets said source.
5. A 6-inch cast iron pipe at the point where an unnamed street connecting High and the Sandalfoot Lane Road, situated between the above described roads crosses car tracks near Sandhill Hill and Faber Company.
6. A 6-inch cast iron pipe at the point where Colonial Avenue, on Riverside, crosses right of way and tracks of the Faber Company.
7. A 6 1/2 inch cast iron pipe at the point where Cedar Lane Road crosses car tracks at the intersection of May Street, Nottingham Hill.
8. A 6-inch cast iron pipe on Brookside Street at the intersection of Bradmore Road, near Nottingham Hill.

And the aforesaid herein before named and agrees in consideration of said license:

First: That this license is a personal privilege to the holder and is not transferable or assignable, and any attempt to transfer or assign the same shall operate as a forfeiture thereof.

Second: That in the installation and construction of said pipe by the licensee shall conform to such requirements as may be prescribed by said Faber Company, and at all times hereunder and during the existence of the same upon the right of way of the Faber Company, the licensee, well aware that the said pipe may be liable to, or interfere with the same, or the safe and proper maintenance of the road bed, or the tracks or structures upon the same or endanger the life or health of employees of the Faber Company, or other persons upon the right of way and premises of the Faber Company.

Third: That in the event the Faber Company shall, at any time hereinafter during the life of this agreement make any changes in the road bed or the structures upon the said right of way, and shall find it necessary to disturb said pipe in so doing, then in such event the licensee will, at its own cost and expense, upon notice in writing, so to do, served upon it by the Faber Company, change the location of said pipe, and thereafter maintain the same hereunder, so that the said pipe shall not interfere with the works of the Faber Company.

Fourth: That the privilege hereby granted is to be used and enjoyed at the risk of the licensee and in consideration of the benefits to be derived therefrom by the licensee, it covenants hereby that it will indemnify and save harmless the Faber Company against all and any losses, dues, injury, damage or expense incurred from or by reason of the construction or maintenance of the said pipe line upon and across the right of way, or premises and under the tracks of the Faber Company, or by the use of the same by the licensee hereunder, whether such loss, injury, damage or expense is due in whole, or in part, proportionately or
